# PANDA CARES THROUGH THE YEARS











Panda Cares was established and the Panda Cares Food Donation Program began with **21,000+ meals served** to children in the first year.

The first Panda Cares Charity Golf Invitational was held raising **\$57,500.** 






\$3.6 Million was raised in three weeks to support Hurricanes Harvey and Irma relief efforts in partnership with American Red Cross and Tzu Chi Foundation. Team Panda served 11,500 meals to first responders, hospitals and shelters.

The Covid-19 Community Care Fund provided \$13 Million in cash, PPE and other supplies to support frontline healthcare workers and communities impacted by the pandemic. Team Panda donated 60,000 meals to feed frontline workers across the U.S.



Panda committed to an \$8.8 Million Grant with Boys & Girls Clubs of America (BGCA) for academic programming, the largest single-year donation in their history.



A record-breaking \$5.38 Million was raised at the 25th Panda Cares Charity Golf Invitational in Palm Desert, CA.

Panda Associates celebrated the opening of the 100th Panda Cares Center of Hope, the first Center to support public housing, situated in the heart of the Estrada Courts Housing Community in Los Angeles, CA.





# PANDA CARES CENTER OF HOPE





Panda strives to ensure that the youth in our communities have a safe space where they can learn, play, and receive the necessary guidance and support needed to be at their best. Through our partnerships with Children's Miracle Network Hospitals and Boys & Girls Clubs of America, we help establish Panda Cares Center of Hope (PCCOH) programs for patients and students nationwide.

# Children's Miracle Network Hospitals



PCCOHs within Children's Miracle Network Hospitals provide a calming environment where patients and their families can step away from the overwhelming atmosphere of a hospital and have access to programs and services that address their mental, emotional, physical, and spiritual needs through therapeutic outlets, counseling, and educational opportunities for hospitalized children.

## Boys & Girls Clubs



PCCOHs in Boys & Girls Clubs support students in their academic journey within a safe, supportive, and interactive learning space, giving youth access to state-of-the-art learning supplies, mentorship, and other resources. The Panda-funded Project Learn program offers high-yield learning activities including project-based learning, STEM programs, and financial literacy education. In 2024 we launched the Panda Cares Scholars Program for Boys & Girls Clubs, awarding 72 scholarships to Club members.



Project Learn was implemented across all 578 Panda-funded Club sites in 2024. This program is the primary learning strategy Clubs rely on to support academic success and is adapted to fit the cultural and community needs of every location.

Yakima Children's Village is a one-of-a-kind medical facility where kids with chronic conditions get all their care in one place, including the PCCOH therapy gym which offers services like therapeutic play, physical and occupational therapy, and behavioral health services, designed to give children the skills and strength to thrive. Zane, now 4, lost his legs after a severe infection as a baby. Thanks to the programs and services offered within the therapy gym, he received the critical support he needed to take his first steps with prosthetic legs.


